This introductory 2 day workshop also emphasizes the importance of working with people to clarify expectations, define roles, and build commitment. The first day is an overview of the topic areas and the second day is a practical case project starting at initiation, through planning, execution, and control to closure for practice in applying the skills learned.

Topic areas:

- What are: projects, project management, and project managers.
- Know the destination: scope definition.
- Laying a route: work breakdown structure, schedule, and risk.
- The human side: resources, responsibilities, and relationships.
- Making headway: controlling scope, reporting progress.

Facilitator: Allison Atkey, Atkey Consulting Inc. has managed a wide range of projects including project launches, organization change initiatives, and application development. Over 2,500 individuals have learned about project management at her workshops or courses, including those at University of Manitoba and Red River College.
