Confronted with issues such as global competition, the speed of change and the demand for continuous performance improvement, managers and leaders need practical skills and proven methods for resolving problems and making sound decisions.

At this two day workshop, learn to understand the structure of problem solving and decision making by using a three part model. Examples, case studies, and real work situations will be used to demonstrate the model and strengthen understanding.

Participants will gain practical techniques for:

- Determining what problems to focus on and deciding who should be involved in solving the problem.
- Clarifying what the problem is and gathering information about the problem.
- Determining and analyzing the causes. Finding the root cause.
- Getting buy-in and support along the way.
- Clarifying what the solution must do, then generating and weighting alternative solutions.
- Selecting appropriate courses of action and creating an action plan.
- Anticipating implementation problems.
- Determining performance measures and verifying solutions.
- Keeping a team focused on the problem-solving process.
